## God breathed Words: Why does God want us to have the Bible?

Five Things the Holy Spirit wants us to see from 2<sup>nd</sup> Timothy 3:16

### I. Scripture is God-breathed

- A. Only time word is used in Scripture - *theopneustos*: - *theos* - God (theology) - *pneo* - wind/blow
- B. Which Scripture is God-breathed? *pas* – ALL

### II. Scripture is Profitable Doctrine

- A. *ophelimos didaskalia* - “profitable doctrine” – doctrine is a noun – the teaching itself is a “thing”.
- B. The verb “to teach” is root word *didasko* – In Great Commission “teaching them to observe all I have commanded you”
  - 1. What kind of *didaskalia* is there?
    - a. Mark 7:1-8 – Man-made doctrine and doctrines of God
    - b. Ephesians 4:11-16 – there are false doctrines
    - c. 1<sup>st</sup> Timothy 1:3 -11 – only teach sound doctrine

### III. Scripture is for Reproof

- A. “Reproof” – or rebuking – is another noun from a verb - “proof of the proving”
- B. “Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen” Hebrews 11:1 (ESV)

#### **IV. Scripture is for Correction**

A. Luke 13:10-17

B. Psalm 119:9-16

#### **V. Scripture is for Righteous Instruction**

A. Acts 20:28 – 31b

#### **VI. For What Purpose is this God-breathed Scripture? v.17**

“So that...” Complete AND Equipped FOR Good Works

#### **VII. My “Take Away”**

God gives us His Word to take action and not to memorize Greek sentence structure or to compete with Poor Richard’s Almanac.
