

# Jesus, the Trinity and a 5-way Test

## I. <u>Recall 2<sup>nd</sup> Timothy 3:16-17</u> – There is "profitable doctrine"

A. The Greek word for doctrine is *didaskalia* – we see it used in the New Testament to describe different doctrines:

- 1. <u>Mark 7:1-8</u> Man-made doctrine and doctrines of God there is a difference between the two
- 2. Ephesians 4:11-16 there are false doctrines
- 3. <u>1<sup>st</sup> Timothy 1:3-11</u> only sound doctrine should be taught

#### II. What is Fundamental Doctrine? How do we identify it? (From John MacArthur)

- A. It must come from Scripture sola Scriptura
- B. They are clear in Scripture no secret decoder rings. Example: Trinity (there but not)
- C. Everything essential to saving faith depends on it
  - 1. Jesus is the Messiah
  - 2. Resurrection is real
  - 3. Justification by faith

D. Anything we are forbidden to deny

- Sin (1<sup>st</sup> John 1)
  Love
- 3. Incarnate Christ
- E. It's summed up in Jesus' work and as a person

He is the Logos
 His atoning death, resurrection, miracles

## III. The Trinity

A. Dr. Wayne Grudem's Three Statements:

- 1. God is three persons.
- 2. Each person is fully God.
- 3. There is one God.

B. Trinity Glimpses in the Old Testament

- 1. Genesis 1:26 "us" and "our"
- 2. Psalm 110:1 "LORD" and "Lord"
  - a. Primary OT Names for God Psalm 16:1-2
    - 1) Elohim (El) God or god <u>Exodus 15:11a</u> "Who is like you, O LORD, among the gods?"
    - 2) Adonay Lord
    - 3) YHWH LORD
  - b. YHWH Masoretes (about 950 AD) Aaron ben Moses ben Asher Masoretic Text MT
- 3. Isaiah 63:10 grieving "his Holy Spirit"

#### C. New Testament Revelation

- 1. Matthew 3:16-17
- 2. <u>1<sup>st</sup> Peter 1:1-2</u>

D. God is Three Persons

- 1. God the Father John 1:1-2
- 2. God the Son  $1^{st}$  John 2:1
- 3. God the Holy Spirit John 14:26

E. Each Person is Fully God

- 1. God the Father is fully God (not a hard one)
- 2. God the Son is fully God John 20:24-29
- 3. God the Holy Spirit is fully God <u>Matthew 28:16-20</u>
