a) John 19:39

b) <u>Nehemiah 9:26</u> - they "killed Your prophets"

c) <u>Matthew 23:37</u> – "Jerusalem who kills the prophets"

- d) <u>Matthew 23:31</u> "you are the sons...who murdered the prophets"
- e)  $1^{st}$  Thessalonians 2:15 the Jews "who killed both the Lord Jesus and the prophets"

A. <u>Matthew 1:1-17</u> - Four women in the genealogy: Ruth, Rahab, Bathsheba and Tamar - All come from sexual sin - 3 are Gentiles – the only Hebrew is not named (Bathsheba)

B. Tamar – from Genesis 38

- C. Ruth from Moab Genesis 19:30-38
- D. Rahab Prostitute Joshua 2:8-14
- E. "Uriah's wife" (Bathsheba) <u>2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel 11</u>
